## Principal's Report

This week's news:

- Floods Impact—This continues for many people. Our thoughts are with these people and if you or anyone you know requires assistance, we have information about where to receive the appropriate assistance.
- NAPLAN—The 2022 NAPLAN Assessments will be undertaken by Year 3 in May. This week Year 3 will undertake an Omnibus Test. This is not an assessment, but a check of the online capacity to complete the actual assessments.
- **COVID**—COVID has not gone away and there is a new variant. It is important to remember that if your child has any of the following symptoms:
  - fever (37.5 degrees Celsius or higher)  $\Diamond$
  - cough  $\Diamond$
  - sore throat
  - shortness of breath (difficulty breathing)
  - runny nose  $\Diamond$
  - loss of taste  $\Diamond$
  - loss of smell

#### Other reported symptoms include:

- fatique  $\Diamond$
- acute blocked nose (congestion)  $\Diamond$
- muscle pain
- joint pain  $\Diamond$
- headache  $\Diamond$
- diarrhoea  $\Diamond$
- nausea/vomiting  $\Diamond$
- loss of appetite

If anyone develops any of these symptoms they should get tested and isolate until they receive a negative test result.

Parents are allowed to visit the school for events, but if they are volunteering for a specific activity, they must be double vaccinated.

• <u>Skool Loop</u>—We are in the process of setting up Skool Loop. This is a different app to Seesaw. Skool Loop will be used for administration information e.g newsletters, easier access to paying online, important information and advising of absences.
