## Principal's Report

This week's news:

#### Attendance

Please remember that it is the law to attend school between the ages of 6 and 17. If your child is unable to attend, we require a written note or a telephone call. If a note or phone call is not received within 7 days, your child will be marked absent with no good reason. Partial absences also require a note or reason. School rolls are legal documents.

- **COVID**—COVID has not gone away and there is a new variant. It is important to remember that if your child has any of the following symptoms:
  - fever (37.5 degrees Celsius or higher)  $\Diamond$
  - cough  $\Diamond$
  - sore throat  $\Diamond$
  - shortness of breath (difficulty breathing)
  - runny nose
  - loss of taste  $\Diamond$
  - loss of smell

#### Other reported symptoms include:

- $\Diamond$ fatique
- acute blocked nose (congestion)  $\Diamond$
- muscle pain  $\Diamond$
- joint pain  $\Diamond$
- headache
- diarrhoea  $\Diamond$
- nausea/vomiting  $\Diamond$
- loss of appetite

If anyone develops any of these symptoms they should get tested and isolate until they receive a negative test result.

Parents are allowed to visit the school for events, but if they are volunteering for a specific activity, they must be double vaccinated.

We are reminded that vaccinations are recommended.

• <u>Skool Loop</u>—We are in the process of setting up Skool Loop. This is a different app to Seesaw. Skool Loop will be used for administration information e.g newsletters, easier access to paying online, important information and advising of absences.

To access this app, please search Skool Loop in your Play Store or App Store and download for free.

- Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) The Premier's Reading Challenge continues. Each student is involved in this challenge. K/1/2 students are required to read or have read to them 30 books (25 must be Challenge books and 5 of their own choice). Years 3/4/6 are required to read 20 books (15 must be Challenge books and 5 of their own choice). Books will be exchanged on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings before school. The Challenge concludes on 19th August, 2022.
