### Principal's Report

This week's news:

- Welcome: Welcome back to Term 2. We have a busy term ahead of us with lots happening (Grandparents' Day, Cross Country, Biggest Morning Tea to name a few).
- ANZAC Day: ANZAC Day is on Monday, 25th April. Our students participate in the Casino ANZAC Day March. Students participating are to wear their school uniform and meet in front of the Richmond Valley Library in Casino at 9.45am. Please wear sunscreen, as it gets quite hot.
- Grandparents' Day: This will be held on Monday, 2nd May, 2022. The agenda will be the same as previous with Morning Tea at 10.30am followed by visits to the classrooms.
- <u>C.L.A.S.S.</u> Cross Country: Will take place at Queen Elizabeth Park Oval 2 in Casino on Friday, 6th May, 2022. The students will be running on a circular course and on tarmac. We will travel to Casino by bus leaving the school at 8.55am.
- <u>Attendance</u>: Student attendance is important for their continued academic development. Children are required to attend school from the age of 6 until the age of 17. Absences from school require a reason from parents/carers to be forwarded to the school either by phone, note, Seesaw or Skool Loop. Partial absences (late arrivals—15 minutes or more, early leaving—15 minutes or more) also require this information. School Rolls are legal documents.

It is important to note that for partial absences, the Department of Education tallies the minutes absent and when it reaches 120 minutes, that is counted as a half day absence.

- **COVID**—Term 2 instructions -
  - \* Contact rules have been relaxed. This is how they apply to school—Students and staff who have a household contact with COVID do not need to isolate for 7 days if the following apply—No symptoms, RAT testing for 5 days before attending school (Negative result), wearing masks indoors (highly recommended for primary students)
  - \* Parents are allowed to visit the school for events, but if they are volunteering for a specific activity like tuckshop, they must be double vaccinated.

We are reminded that vaccinations are recommended.

- <u>Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC)</u> The Premier's Reading Challenge continues. Each student is involved in this challenge. K/1/2 students are required to read or have read to them 30 books (25 must be Challenge books and 5 of their own choice). Years 3/4/6 are required to read 20 books (15 must be Challenge books and 5 of their own choice). Books will be exchanged on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings before school. The Challenge concludes on 19th August, 2022.
- Jump Rope for Heart—This term our students will be participating in Jump Rope for Heart, a fundraising activity for the Heart Foundation. Registration forms will be sent home this week.
- Skool Loop—Has been set up. This is a different app to Seesaw. Skool Loop will be used for administration information e.g newsletters, easier access to paying online, important information and advising of absences.
