# <u>Principal's Report</u>



- **Intensive Swimming:** This is now complete. We have seen some good progress by the students and their confidence has developed.
- **<u>Rappville Sleepover:</u>** Aylah and Amity enjoyed their time at Rappville and participated well with the Rappville students.
- **Rappville Activities:** Our planned excursion to Rappville Public School has unfortunately had to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances with the activity providers.
- Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary: Permission notes need to be completed and returned.
- Bushfire Information: It is now bushfire season. Our school is classed as a Category 2 School for bushfires. This means that if the Fire Rating for a day is Catastrophic, our school would be required to become non-operational for that day. If a bushfire was close at hand and we needed to evacuate, our first point of evacuation is King's gate. The school would then contact the families of the students. In extreme circumstances our school would evacuate to Casino High School, our designated Evacuation Centre.
- **Mobile Library:** The Mobile Library will be at the school on Wednesday, 29th November. All welcome.
- <u>COVID19</u>: COVID19 is still around. There are many cases at present in the Casino area. Please remember it is important to remain vigilant and if your child/ children have symptoms, please test them and keep them at home until the symptoms are no longer evident. If you require more RAT tests we have some at school.

Remember that hay fever is around and may have similar symptoms to a cold. If your child suffers from hay fever it is alright for them to be at school.
