Principal's Report

This week's news:

- Intensive Swimming: Commences this week and continues for two weeks. You should see improvement in swimming during this time.
- Rappville Sleepover: An information sheet will be forwarded to you on Monday, 6th November.
- Bushfire Information: It is now bushfire season. Our school is classed as a Category 2 School for bushfires. This means that if the Fire Rating for a day is Catastrophic, our school would be required to become non-operational for that day. If a bushfire was close at hand and we needed to evacuate, our first point of evacuation is King's gate. The school would then contact the families of the students. In extreme circumstances our school would evacuate to Casino High School, our designated Evacuation Centre.

- **Mobile Library:** The Mobile Library will be at the school on Wednesday, 15th November.
