This week's news:

- **COVID19:** COVID19 has been in our school, so please continue to observe the regulations related to this. No one is to attend school if they have any symptoms, e.g. runny nose, cough, sore throat, etc.

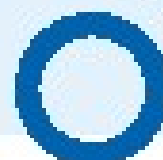

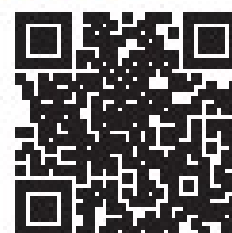
